
EG 1907/2006 REACH

Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemical substances.

As a supplier of articles (brackets, masts, profiles, screws, nuts, etc.) mandatory registration according to the REACH regulation does not apply to us. Nor are we obliged to notify according to article 7.2 & 7.3.

According to article 33 of REACH, Cue Dee is however obligated to provide the recipient of the article with sufficient information to allow safe use of the article including, as a minimum, the name of that substance when an article contains any substances of very high concern (SVHC) in a concentration above 0.1 % weight by weight (w/w).

As of 5 January 2021, whenever a SVHC content exceeds 0.1% (w/w) in the article level, data should also be submitted to ECHA SCIP database, established in the Waste Frame Directive.
