Information about processing of personal data at CueDee AB

It is important that you feel safe when you provide information about yourself to CueDee AB. We pay great attention to the protection of personal integrity.

This policy explains how we collect and use your personal data. It also describes your rights vis-à-vis us and how you can assert your rights. You can always contact us if you have any questions about privacy and data protection by sending an e-mail to info@cuedee.com.

To fulfil our obligations to staff, customers, and suppliers, we need to process your personal data as described below. We do this with the utmost consideration for your privacy.

Information we collect may include:

Personal contact information:

Name, date of birth, social security number, billing and delivery address, e-mail address, Mobile phone number, etc.

The information you provide to us is generally necessary to enter a contractual relationship with us, while the other information we collect is generally necessary for other purposes.

Who may we share your information with?

We take all reasonable legal, technical, and organisational measures to ensure that your data is handled securely.

Suppliers and subcontractors such as companies within our group

We may share your personal data with suppliers or subcontractors for the performance of our contractual obligations to you.

Authorities

We may provide necessary information to authorities such as the police, the tax authorities and the Swedish Tax Agency.

or other authorities if we are required to do so by law or if you have consented to us doing so. An example of a legal obligation to provide information is for measures against money laundering and terrorist financing.

What we will NOT do with your data

We will not sell your personal data to third parties without your consent.



Your rights of access, rectification, and deletion

Right to access your personal data

You can request a copy (register extract) of the information you would like to know and verify the information we hold about you. The copy is free to request.

Right to rectification

You have the right to correct inaccurate or incomplete information about yourself.

Right to deletion ("right to be forgotten")

You have the right to request deletion of your personal data in cases where the data is no longer necessary for the purpose for which it was collected. However, there may be legal obligations such as:

prevent us from immediately deleting parts of your data. These obligations come from accounting, tax, banking, and anti-money laundering legislation, but also from consumer rights law. In such cases, we block the data that we are obliged to save from being used for purposes other than fulfilling such legal obligations.
